Pool Rules & Regulations

The following Pool Rules and Regulations are for the protection of the residents in the community and to help assure that every resident in Brighton Bay enjoys the pool season:

1. Pool Hours are 9 AM to 10 PM.
2. Please use the pool at your own risk. We do not have a lifeguard on duty at any time.
3. The gates to the pool area must remain closed at all times. Do not prop the gates open in any way at any time for any reason.
4. There should be no solo swimming.
5. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. The accompanying adult must be 18 years of age or older.
6. Glass objects of any kind are not allowed inside the pool area.
7. No running or rough play is allowed.
8. Throwing any objects including balls is prohibited.
9. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
10. Proper swim attire is required at all times. This means bathing suits only, no cut offs, street clothes or underwear.
11. Training pants with snug fitting rubber pants or the newly designed swim diapers are REQUIRED for any infant/child not toilet trained. Fecal contamination will cause the pool to close while water treatment is conducted.
12. There should be no spitting or blowing of nose in the pool.
13. Persons with diarrhea or nausea should not enter the pool.
14. Persons with skin, eye or respiratory infections should not enter the pool.
15. Persons should shower before entering pool.
16. No animals or pets allowed in the pool or inside the gated pool area with the exception of certified service animals which are allowed inside the gates.
17. Audio devices (including radios, TV's, etc.) are prohibited unless used with a personal headset.
18. Residents must accompany their guests and accept full responsibility for them.
19. Please clean up your area when leaving the pool and discard trash in appropriate containers and close the umbrellas to avoid wind damage.
20. The following items are not allowed inside the pool area: Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, rollerblades, large floats or floating chairs.
21. In addition to these rules, all rules posted at the pool must be adhered to.

If you witness any violations to the above rules and regulations it is your right and duty as a resident to ask the violator to stop the behavior and if they do not cooperate, call the Beaufort County Police at 843-785-3618. If you are able to photograph the offender, by all means do and send the photos to IMC and/or your Board members especially if there is damage to property involved. The pool is for the exclusive use and enjoyment of Brighton Bay residents and their invited guests.
